Tomorrow is the Feast Day of St Catherine of Siena, our Patron Saint. This means that it is also the Feast Day of our parish. One of the celebrations will be a dinner for us to celebrate our parish Feast Day together and this will take place on 6th May. ST CATHERINE OF SIENA (Feast Day April 29)

Born in Siena, on 25 March 1347, Catherine was the youngest of 26 children.

During her youth, she had to contend with her parents trying to marry her off, which she strongly resisted. Even-

tually they let her join the lay order, the Third Order of St Dominic.

She lived in poverty, prayed extensively and routinely visited people who were sick, in hospital and in prison. She also dictated books full of spiritual inspiration. She died on April 29, 1380 and was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1970.
