As previously mentioned, there will be a parish mission held here from 28th to 30th August. The archdiocese has invited Mr John Pridmore to lead the missions in five parishes of the archdiocese and we are one of them. The title of the mission is "Gangland to Promised Land – Melbourne Tour." John will also be here to talk to us at the Masses of 26th and 27th August. Since the mission will run on the evening of Tuesday 29th August, our parish Mass on that day will be at 9:30am, preceded by Adoration and Confession at 8:30am.

It will also be an opportunity for formation and discussion and praying together as leaders of our parish. May I please ask that you keep our ministry coordinators, the members of our Evangelisation Team and Leadership Team in your prayers as we undergo the formation to enable us to be agents of missionary renewal in our parish.

We continue turning to our patron saint and we ask for her intercession.
