For many years, Russel's relationship with Jesus was on a strictly 'needs basis'... 'I always believed in Jesus and I knew there was something out there that kept me grounded,' he says, 'but I never understood a lot, and I didn't push to learn more. And life just continued.'

Some years ago though, Russel was invited to participate in Alpha. Through the shared meal, the weekly videos and the discussions in his small group, he was connected to a group of parishioners with whom he has become close. He was nervous to begin with but approached it with an open mind. 'The dynamics of our little group were amazing. It was a good mix, and within a few sessions I could see everyone opening up, sharing, and I just felt something changed.' A significant turning point came on the Alpha Retreat Day, when his small group leaders offered to pray with him. The experience prompted him to go to confession for the first time in many years. 'I felt this big load just go away from me,' he says. 'I can be quite emotional, so I had a few tears in my eyes.' These days, Jesus figures prominently in his life, and increasingly he wants to share his experience with others.

I had been saying no for a while (to Alpha)...but my kids were bigger now and I had no excuses to say no to it! (laughs), so I thought I'm gonna go for it...just trust in the process. And now I love it...it's brought me back to the basics (of faith).



In my faith journey, with some health issues, I might have got angry with God once or twice (laughs). But now I'm learning to trust and let go. With Alpha, (it helped) to have a

committed time each week to connect with other people on a faith level. Sometimes, I might take on one thing or two things...it might be something like trust or the Bible or the little questions that we have... it all built on the process of just being and sharing.

We learnt how to pray through Alpha...it helped me to deal with the situations I need

to deal with everyday in my life especially at work and at home...to know that God has your back in every situation...and to have that confidence which helps us to help others.

Makes our life more meaningful. No matter how tired you are ...you still felt refreshed after (an Alpha session).

Together (as a couple) we have grown. We have made some friends, met like-minded people...a community that helps us to grow...It's the stories behind Alpha...that are encouraging. It's a renewal of faith...it helps us remember the good things about being Catholic, brings our faith to the foreground. So give it a try...you may just surprise yourself...


