Q1) What brought you to Alpha? - I was born into the faith, and lived my faith all along, and was looking for something more to inspire me...

©2) Has there been anything ...any stumble blocks in the faith that Alpha has helped address? – Yes, it is the Holy Spirit side of things that I'm finding quite interesting...that's the driving force. I started off a little sceptical (about the course), thinking we were born into the Catholic faith...but as I have gone

along I can see ...the ways in which the Holy Spirit is trying to get a message across to me...

Q3) Would you feel comfortable inviting someone to Alpha? Absolutely...I said to a friend after the first week (of doing Alpha), "listen there is this opportunity there, how about joining us for Alpha..." I say to people "keep an open mind, the videos are easy to take in, they are not imposing, you just need to listen...and you never know (what you might hear)."

Mara:

Q1) How are you finding Alpha...? Alpha has been a good refresh, a restart...along my faith journey... it's been a good place to ask questions, to go back to the essence of what my faith is...why we do things the way we do...and have that understanding and be able to talk to other people. As I get a little bit older, it's good to take a step back and think what am I doing, what am I aiming for, and continue to have God as the centre of that. I start to redirect my path a bit...the noise of the world can really distract you and finding that path again is really important.



©2) Did you have a struggle to come to the Alpha course? Yes! I had been attending the Church during Easter...and I had heard about the Alpha course, and I had been saying to God...what is next...and I thought maybe this is God calling me, asking to come. So I thought, let's go for it. I do attend another prayer group...so it is a commitment to come an extra day to Church ...but I think it is worth it.

Q3) What would you say to people wondering whether to join? Come with an open mind. It is a good space to ask questions, start to develop that faith – it is a big opportunity that can really help you along your way, if you are a bit confused, not sure where you are going...what the next step is...I would definitely recommend people come and experience it...

 ∞ 4) You are one of the younger members – how have you found that? I find it nice to see different age ranges, people from different backgrounds...it's a nice space to have...and to question...it's good to be around people of faith, people who are still on their journey, it's a really nice environment to be in...

Q1) How are you finding Alpha so far? I think Alph is fantastic! It's really helped me gain a greater depth in how God's relationship with each one of us is really important...and this is underestimated by today's society...if we all had God and Alpha in our lives no one would struggle as much. It's really helped my mental health personally.

Q2) What made you come to Alpha – I heard about it from friends who came to our Parish...and they encouraged me to give it a go...I felt I needed something more in my life...

Q3) Have there been questions or stumbling blocks that Alpha has helped address? Absolutely - the questions of everyday faith, and how we can pray and how we can understand prayer more...

Q4) As a younger person, how have you found it? The videos we have been shown are very practical to the younger generations, to the younger person. It really gives a greater depth of meaning ... regardless of age and background.
