ST CATHERINE OF SIENA

Be who God meant you to be and you will set the world ablaz

This is evangelisation! When we meet someone who makes us feel loved and valued – we are reminded of God's love for us. When we forget ourselves and seek the good of the other – we remind each other of the grander plan God has for us, a plan that uses all of us, not just a few. When we give of our time to help, when we meet after Mass to share in a barbeque and a laugh, when we ask others how their week has been, share a story



about a grandchild's antics, or place an arm around someone who feels low, we are showing the love of God, we are reinforcing the importance of Christian community, we are softening the hardships of life, we are being Christian, we are being Catholic! And people see this, and are drawn towards us and our way of life.

Evangelising in our everyday life is not difficult. It does not need strong, righteous words, or quotes from the Bible. It does not necessarily need the moral lawbook to be pulled out and shaken in front of people. It needs us to look someone in the eye when we speak to them, so they can see we care for them and love them. It needs us to allow our heart to speak to their heart, softly and gently, so we do not push people away but draw them in. It certainly does not need self-righteousness and judgement, but a clear sense of our own frailty and flaws. When we spend time identifying the ways in which we fall short, and realise we have inner wounds that will, at times, make us snarl or show our claws like a pet nursing an injured paw, we can then understand when others do the same to us. Evangelising is journeying gently beside others so they can sense, through us, the beauty and goodness of our invisible God. Let an encounter with you, for someone, be an encounter with God.

In the Alpha program we quote Pope Francis' words "let's make Jesus' last command our first priority - go and make disciples". A first step in this is to get ourselves ready to be used by God. Do we find quiet time to listen to God, not just request petitions? Are we prepared to confess and clear the slate of our heart so the Holy Spirit has fewer obstacles to get past? Are we willing to say we are wrong, we are nowhere near perfect, that we have still much to learn? Is our heart soft and ready to love?

Today's Gospel reminds us of how offtrack we can go if we think too much of living for ourselves and our advantage. We know the Bible says we do not need to actually murder someone, but just being angry or hating someone can be as bad. So let us be determined to find quiet prayer time to check our motivations and our own judgments. Let us allow the Holy Spirit to point out our faults. So that we grow more like Jesus, and by doing so, draw others to Him and His delightful love for each of us.
