When Tash asked me to join the evangelisation team in October 2021, I had no idea why. I'll be honest, I didn't know the first thing about "evangelisation", but I guess Tash saw something I didn't. What I did know at the time is that I wanted to serve God & I trusted in His will for me. So, I said yes! What I slowly but surely came to know, is that through my own encounter & conversion in April 2019 I had been evangelised. We too will need to sacrifice to bring God's children to Him.

So, in the lead up to the mission I have been tasked with, to lead an amazing team of evangelisers & for evangelisation in our parish community let us ground all we do in prayer. Please, pray to God, pray for the intercessions of our blessed Mother Mary, St. Catherine of Siena & all the angels & saints, to guide the evangelisation team & you our parishioners in our mission to bring God's people home.
