

Townhall:

Firstly, sincerest thanks to all who attended our Townhall on the 9th of May. It's always encouraging to see community members coming together to discuss parish matters and provide feedback. Highlighting the financial situation and providing updates on parish activities are crucial aspects of keeping everyone informed and engaged. Fr Richard's emphasis on the path of missionary renewal underscores the parish's commitment to nurturing spiritual growth and fostering encounters with our Lord. 
CORPUS CHRISTI - CANDLELIGHT PROCESSION & BENEDICTION

Next weekend is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi).

As part of this celebration, we invite parishioners to join us in a Eucharistic Procession immediately after the 6pm Vigil Mass on Saturday 1 June.

The procession starts from the church, goes across the footpath at CRC, walks all the way going pass the hall, turns left and continues between the hall and the shed, to the carpark and then process all the way back to the church. During the procession, the Divine Mercy Chaplet will be chanted, and the procession finishes with Benediction in the church. Candles will be provided.

'PAVING THE WAY' PROJECT

It has been decided to cancel the Paving The Way Project.

The Project launched in late 2019 was cancelled as a result of

- Immediate cracking in the concrete whereby the faux concrete paver slabs proposed in the project could not be provided (the slab/s were the items being sponsored).
- All avenues seeking compensation from the concrete supplier, who we believe was primarily at fault, have been unsuccessful.
- The possibility that parts of the pathway, including sponsored parts, may be changed during the Church alterations/expansion currently under consideration.
- The impact of the Covid Pandemic which impacted Church services and attendances reducing the potential for the project to reach maximum potential.

All sponsors to the Project will be contacted on an individual basis wherever possible.


First Communion and Confirmation
